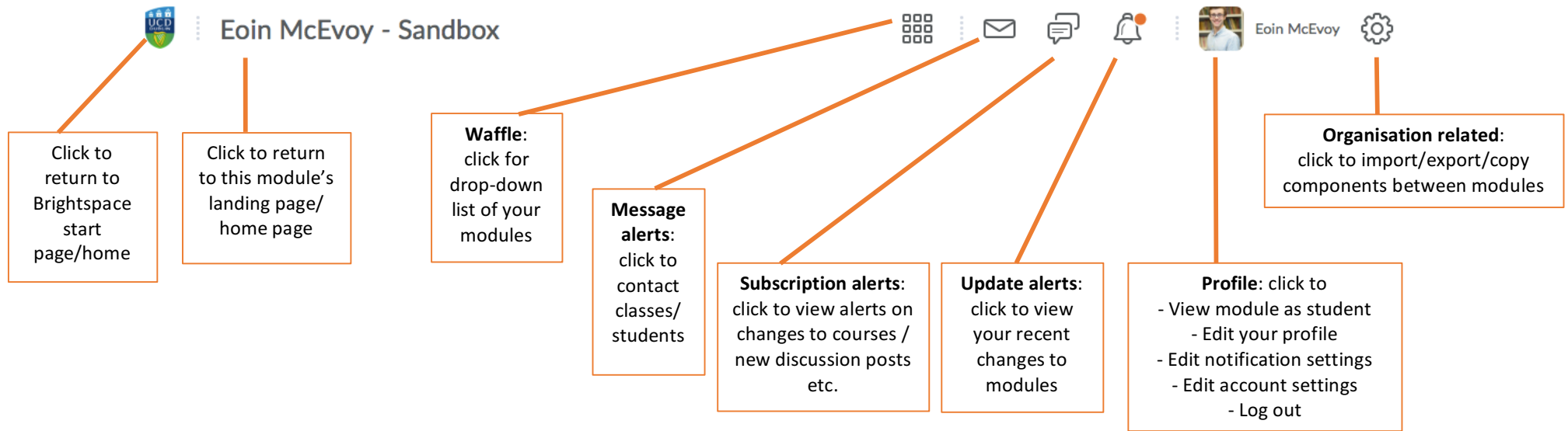
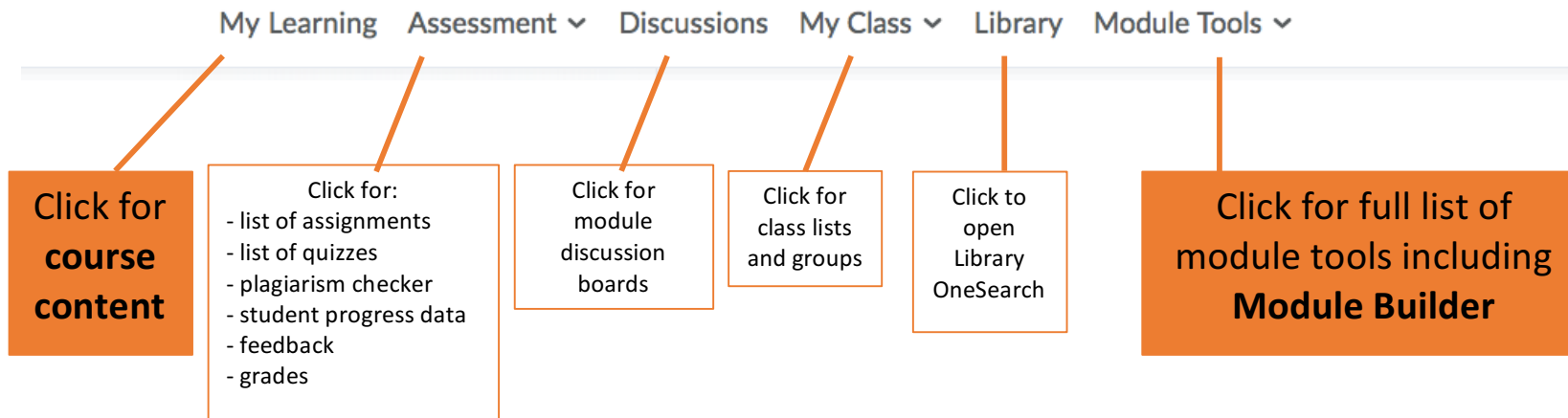


1. Top Navigation Bar
