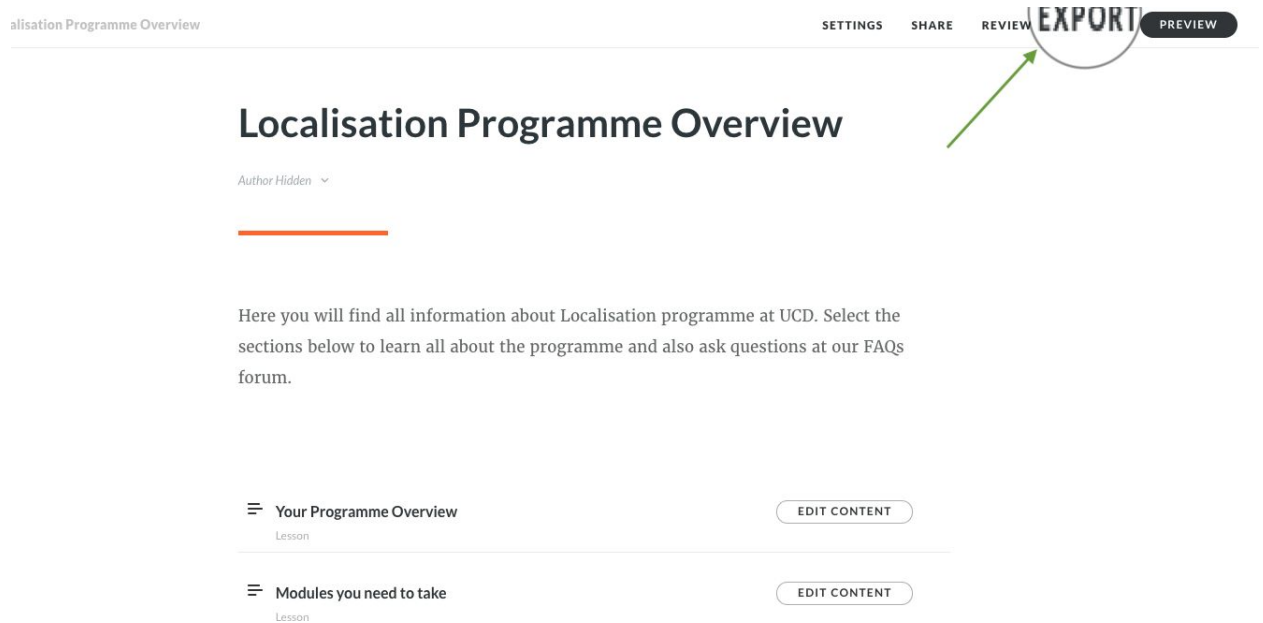


WHAT YOU WILL FIND IN THIS MANUAL

In this manual you will find steps on how to export a resource from Rise and upload to Brightspace.

Follow the steps below to bring your Rise package to Brightspace:

1. Export the package from Rise to SCORM



Make sure you select SCORM 1.2 and for Complete/Incomplete -if your resource does not need to be graded/there is no quiz within it

Tracking

You can track progress and completion in three ways:

- Track using course completion
Set the percentage of the course a learner must finish to mark as completed. 100%
- Track using quiz result
Course has no quizzes.
- Track using Storyline block
Course has no Storyline blocks.

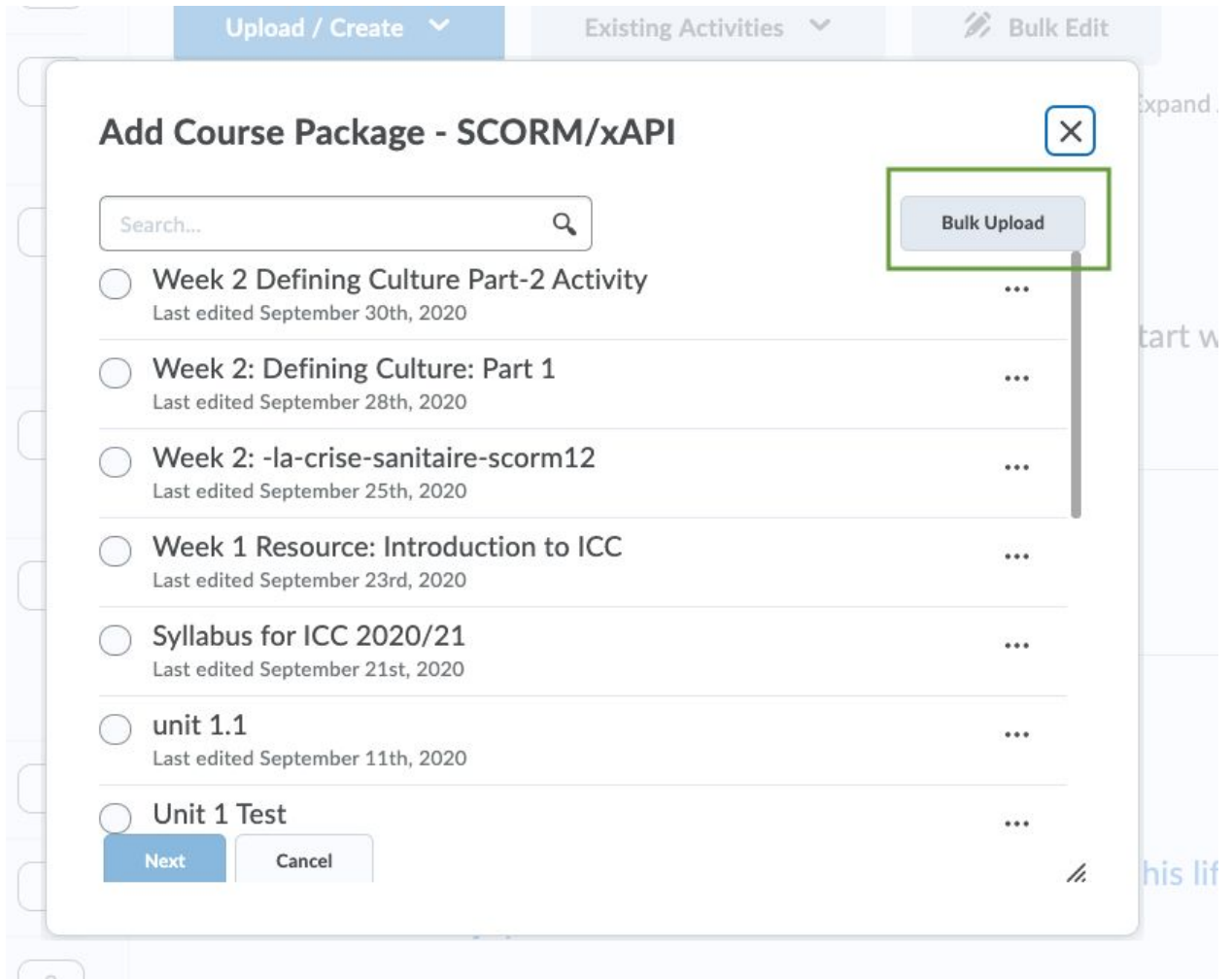
2. Make sure to keep the file zipped and never unzip it

4. Upload / Create a SCORM file

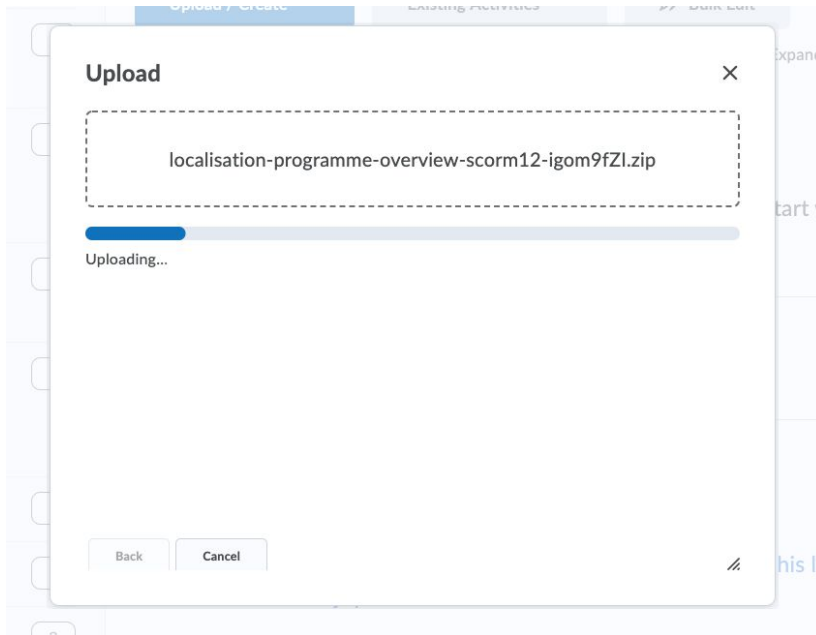
